In exchange for the loan and the exhibit of the banners for public display, the borrowing lodge agrees to perform the following terms and conditions.

- 1. Obtain permission of the borrower’s board and a local museum or an agreed, secure public site for the display of the exhibit banners in their locale, at a location approved by the lending lodge.**
- 2. Handle, pack, and return the 21 banners in the same condition as received, undamaged, to the lending lodge within the agreed period.**
- 3. Provide transport of the banners from St. Paul to the exhibit site and return.**
- 4. In the event a banner is damaged, while in the care and custody of the borrowing SON lodge, the borrowing lodge shall bear and pay the cost of replacement @ \$150 per banner to the lending lodge with 30 days of receipt and notice by the lending lodge to the borrower.**
- 5. The borrowing lodge will use no other method of storage, display and shipping other than specified or approved by the lending lodge in writing, to avoid damage to the museum banners.**
- 6. In the event display space is limited, the borrowing lodge may display fewer than all 21 banners at one time, provided the remaining banners are stored in a safe and secure location without damage, pending the return of all 21 banners of the museum exhibit, as agreed.**
