1. 2026 Synnøve-Nordkap Postsecondary Scholarship Application

Synnøve-Nordkap Lodge offers scholarships for post-secondary education (4 year, 2 year or vocational training) to active Lodge or Junior Lodge members or the children or grandchildren of active Lodge members. The number of scholarships to be awarded as well as the amount of the award will depend upon the number of highly qualified applications received, as well as the state of the Lodge's budget. Past grants have ranged from \$500-\$1500 with the possibility of renewal for those in good academic standing. The Lodge reserves the right to award no scholarships.

Applicants may be either current postsecondary students or high school students intending to pursue post-secondary education in the 2026-2027 school year. Preference will be given to those who have been active Junior Lodge and/or Lodge members. Previous recipients of this scholarship may apply again.

Applications must be mailed to Lodge Scholarship Coordinator Jill Hanson and postmarked by March 15th. Completed applications will be initially reviewed and, if selected for further consideration, the candidates may be asked to interview with the selection committee in May, either by telephone or remotely. Candidate(s) who are selected for scholarships will be notified shortly after that. Any scholarship awarded comes with the expectation of either service to the Lodge and/or a contribution at a Lodge meeting or program, with the minimum being a short talk about what has been done with the scholarship received. In addition, the Lodge would like scholarship winners to be present at its picnic in June 2026 to receive the award formally and in person if possible. The Lodge dispenses monies directly to your institution second semester upon receipt of the successful completion of the first semester by supplying your grade report to the scholarship chair - Jill Hanson at jillhanson65@gmail.com.
